Dear Mr. Marsh:

In accordance with Arizona Administrative Code R11-3-207 and Arizona Revised Statute §27 1277(B), CalPortland Company (CalPortland) submits this Notice of Proposed Change to the Arizona State Mine Inspector (ASMI) approved Aggregate Mined Land Reclamation Plan (Plan) for the Coolidge (Diablo) Mine (Site) located in Coolidge, Arizona.

CalPortland is proposing an amendment to the original 2007 ASMI-approved plan for the reasons below:

- The 2007 approved plan listed the Operator as Diablo Sand & Gravel, LLC. This amendment will change the operator listed in the approved Mining Plan to California Portland Cement Company, who was identified as the operator in the 2015 approved Reclamation Plan Transfer memo.
- The 2007 approved plan requires the removal of one groundwater well, septic tanks, and the hardline power infrastructure following mine closure. This amendment will remove those requirements and leave these items for the post-mining land use (PMLU) at the request of the landowner for the potential resale of the property at the end of mine life and reclamation.
- The 2007 approved plan called for hydroseeding as the method for revegetation. This amendment will change it to allow for natural revegetation with post-reclamation monitoring for a period of two years.

CalPortland believes these changes to the approved Plan to be non-substantial and therefore would not require an amendment to the approved Plan under R11-3-207B.
